ANDREEA CORPODEAN'S CLASS

With Andreea, you will dive into a full-day class combining sculptural jewelry, engineering, and surface design, while creating a reversible piece that can function as both a brooch and a pendant. You'll explore movable and removable elements, hidden construction details, and layered surface effects using pigments, acrylic paints, and iridescent finishes.

For the class, you'll only need to bring a selection of basic sculpting and shaping tools, brushes, cutting tools, and jewelry pliers. Fimo polymer clay materials, wet wipes, a working tile, additional mediums, and components will be prepared for you on-site.

Note: Items marked with a * will be available for purchase at the venue to make your trip to the Czech Republic easier, so there's no need to travel with sharp tools or search for specific materials.

● VARIOUS SHAPING AND SMOOTHING TOOLS

- at least one with silicone or rubber tip, so that it isn't attracted to magnets



● ANY KIND OF SHARP-TIPPED TOOL *



● GUM STIMULATOR

- rubber tipped tool with bended head
- optional, but very useful tool



● MEDIUM STIFF-BRISTLES BRUSH (ROUND OR FLAT)

- can be replaced with a toothbrush



● SMALL ROUND BRUSH

- used for detailing



● MEDIUM SOFT-BRISTLES BRUSHES (ROUND AND FLAT)

- watercolor or makeup brushes
- recommending Ikea's MÅLA brush set
