NOELIA CONTRERAS' CLASS

During Noelia's full-day class, you will explore chain construction and geometry while creating a contemporary necklace made from polymer clay. You'll experiment with different link shapes and proportions, work with color, texture, patterns, and cut-out details, and discover how different connection systems can bring movement and dynamism to your design.

For the class, you'll need to bring basic tools, mini circle cutters, sandpaper, and a hand drill with drill bits. Polymer clay materials, small essential components, a working tile, and other items will be prepared for you.

Note: Items marked with a * will be available for purchase at the venue to make your trip to the Czech Republic easier, so there's no need to travel with sharp tools or search for specific materials.
